# DEAR FRIENDS OF BETHANY HOUSE—

Children represent the largest segment of Bethany's homeless population—we served over **1,450** children last year. Not surprising then, that we chose children as the theme for our 2017 Impact Report. The impact that YOU, our donors and volunteers, play in fulfilling our mission every day is inspiring.

*YOU Gave Children a Home* each time you wrote a check, brought a meal, provided child care or delivered an item or two from our Wish List. YOU are making a difference.

In 2017, we sought additional resources and formed new partnerships to expand our services and meet the ever-growing needs of our families.

- We have seen mental health issues like we have never seen before, which often prevent parents from maintaining employment and positive parenting. New collaborations and on-site services addressed the needs of both parents and children.
- A new Permanent Supportive Housing program started in July provides assistance for families with longer-term needs.
- To ensure families do not return to homelessness, our Post-Shelter Support expanded to an all-time high, with 130 families served.
- Staff trained in Trauma-Informed Care brought a new level of understanding and compassion to services.
- With the knowledge that most people are not aware of the thousands of children experiencing homelessness in Cincinnati, volunteers from our new Speakers Bureau took our message to the community.
- Special outreach to churches communicated the urgency of our needs and the importance of their support.
- Meetings with both elected officials and staff at the city, county, state and federal levels informed policy makers and community leaders on the challenges our families face – lack of affordable housing, transportation, child care, mental health services and decent paying jobs, all of which are associated with generational poverty.




We ended the year in a strong position financially – critical to beginning a Capital Campaign and with a Strategic Plan for 2018-2020!

# Shelter

Bethany House Services (BHS) provides emergency shelter for families living on the streets, in their cars or abandoned buildings, and helps them achieve stable housing and income. The shelter meets each family's immediate needs for safety, housing, food and other necessities and provides a secure environment for parents to plan for their futures. During their stay in a BHS shelter, parents receive comprehensive case management from experienced social workers who guide the families through the process of developing a reality-based plan for ensuring a secure future in stable housing.

## Shelter HIGHLIGHTS

**Shelter bed nights increased** from 48,184 in 2016 to 49,429 in 2017.

**90% of shelter families** exited to positive housing outcomes.

**2-year recidivism\* rates improved**

2016 recidivism for families who exited in 2014 is 21.9%.

2017 recidivism for families who exited in 2015 is 16.1%.

Staff from all departments participated in **Trauma-Informed Care training**. Agency Trainers and Champions were identified to continue employee training and full implementation.

## Children's Services HIGHLIGHTS

**The Ages & Stages Questionnaire**, which reliably identifies young children with developmental delays, is now being administered.

Therapists and Care Coordinators provide **on-site assessments and counseling** for children.

**Increased collaboration** with Cincinnati Public Schools has resulted in an improved school enrollment process and transportation for children.

Children receive **medical and dental services** through the School Based Health Centers.

**Children's Committee of the Board** was reinstated.

We initiated **post-shelter follow-up and support services** for high-risk children leaving shelter.



## Post-Shelter Support

Post-Shelter Support provides assistance for two groups of families: 1) Shelter to Home provides the “up front” funding needed to move families out of shelter as quickly as possible and ensure they have the necessities to establish a home; 2) Aftercare provides emergency assistance to families in danger of losing their home, regardless of how long it has been since they left shelter.

## HIGHLIGHTS

In 2017, 130 families received Post-Shelter Support, a 57% increase over 2016.

54 families who left shelter from 2014 to 2017 received Aftercare services.

The average amount of assistance received was \$802.45.

76 families received Shelter to Home assistance.

### TRAUMA-INFORMED CARE (TIC)

is changing the services that BHS has provided for the past 34 years and the delivery of services across the nation. TIC focuses on a person’s experiences before trying to address the behavior. This different approach is subtle but has a profound effect. Rather than asking, “What’s wrong with you?” the question asked is, “What happened to you?”

# Housing for Families



Bethany House Services (BHS) is the largest provider of HUD-funded housing for families in the Cincinnati/Hamilton County Continuum of Care (CoC) and offers three housing programs: Shelter Diversion, Rapid Re-Housing and Permanent Supportive Housing.

**SHELTER DIVERSION** identifies immediate permanent housing and provides case management and rental assistance for families at imminent risk of homelessness. Shelter Diversion is more cost-effective than entering an Emergency Shelter, plus the family avoids the trauma of homelessness.

**RAPID RE-HOUSING** provides financial assistance and services to quickly re-house and stabilize those families who are experiencing homelessness and living in an Emergency Shelter. The program provides case management, help finding affordable housing, short-term or medium-term rental assistance, credit counseling, security or utility deposits, utility payments and moving expenses.

**PERMANENT SUPPORTIVE HOUSING (PSH)** combines non-time-limited rental assistance with wrap-around supportive services for people with complex needs related to physical or mental health, developmental disabilities or substance use.

## HIGHLIGHTS

### SHELTER DIVERSION

**8% more families** were diverted from shelter directly into permanent housing in 2017.

**84% of the families** increased their self-sufficiency scores during 3-6 months of program participation.

**74% of families** exiting the program increased their income, compared to 65% of families in 2016.

### RAPID RE-HOUSING

Two of BHS' three RRH programs ranked in the **top 10%** of all CoC Housing programs in Hamilton County.

**28% more families** were rapidly re-housed in 2017.

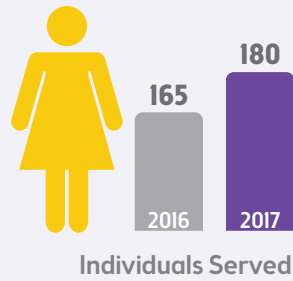
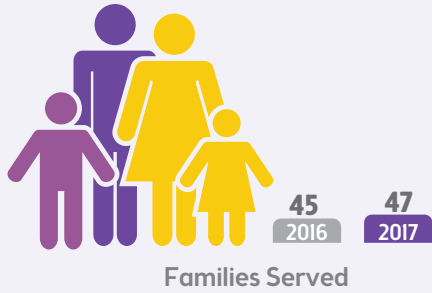
Housing clients now receive diagnostic assessments and ongoing counseling from a new on-site mental health collaboration.

BHS was awarded a fourth Rapid Re-Housing contract starting July 1, 2018.

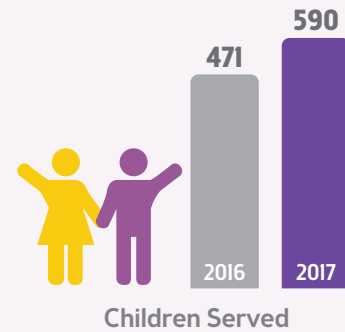
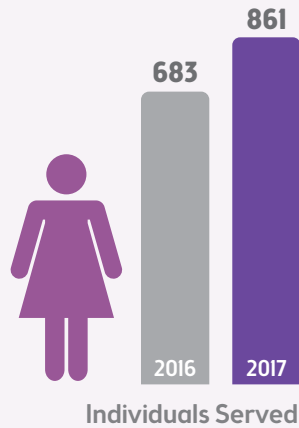
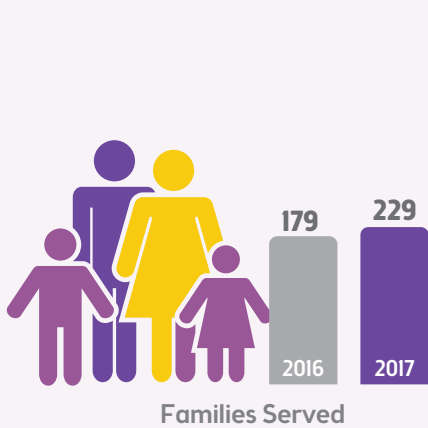
### PERMANENT SUPPORTIVE HOUSING

Since the program began on July 1, 2017, Permanent Supportive Housing has served 100 individuals in families with complex needs.

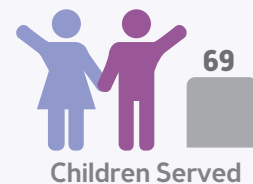
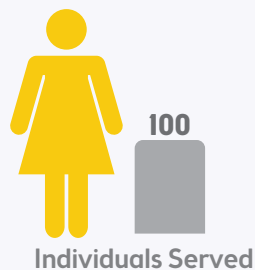
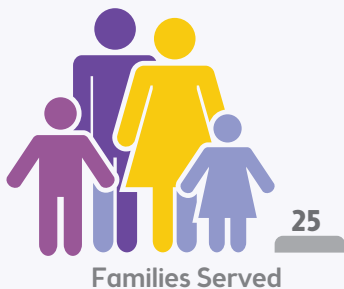

# Affordable Housing



Every family who comes to Bethany House needs permanent, safe, affordable housing. Bethany House's commitment to affordable housing goes back to 1993 when we broke ground on Bethany Homes, a 24-unit apartment building for economically challenged individuals and families, most of whom are supported by a single female working provider. Today Bethany Homes not only provides affordable housing, it also is BHS' social enterprise supporting our mission.

## WHY IS BHS COMMITTED TO AFFORDABLE HOUSING?

Today there is an estimated deficit of 40,000 housing units in Cincinnati and Hamilton County that are affordable and available to extremely low-income households.

## HIGHLIGHTS

In 2017, Bethany Homes had a **NET INCOME OF \$33,000**, which supported BHS operations.

**RENOVATIONS OF BETHANY HOMES** continued in 2017. Many apartments got new hot water heaters, windows, refrigerators, stoves and flooring in the kitchen and bathrooms.

**RESIDENTS BENEFITED** from regular food donations, Christmas gifts, summer cookouts and a variety of activities for the children.

In 2017, volunteers provided monthly weekend brunches, held a Charitable Suds fundraiser at Rhinegeist Brewery and participated in the Bacchanalian Society’s Findlay Market Event. In 2018, they plan to volunteer at the shelter and administration building, continue with weekend brunches, provide quarterly dinners and support Bethany’s three signature events.

# Family Housing Partnership

## four agencies working together!

Since 2000, Bethany House Services has been the HUD applicant and lead agency for funding of case management services for the homeless families in Cincinnati. The level of collaboration among the four agencies within the Family Housing Partnership (FHP) is unique in Cincinnati's social services arena, and today the partnership is stronger than ever. In 2017, the FHP agencies – Bethany House, Interfaith Hospitality Network, Salvation Army and YWCA Greater Cincinnati – made great strides in the implementation of *Solutions for Family Homelessness (S4FH)*, the community-wide plan to make family homelessness rare, brief and a one-time event.

An evidence-based **TRAUMA-INFORMED CARE** training began for all employees of the FHP agencies.

2017 planning for new and enhanced services for homeless families resulted in the rollout of two new components on January 1, 2018 – a uniform, best practice **AFTERCARE PROGRAM** including staffing and an expansion of **EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE** for homeless families at all four agencies.

**THE S4FH CHILDREN AND YOUTH TASK FORCE**, consisting of over 30 professionals representing over 15 organizations, continues to meet monthly to develop strategy and programming, create system change and network with the sole focus of improving services for children and youth experiencing homelessness. This community partnership has resulted in improvements in child care placement, school enrollment and transportation for Cincinnati's homeless children.

# CLIENT STORIES

## "Nothing is going to stop me"

Raised by her grandma who died when she was just a teenager, Lawanda was used to being on her own. She knew she could succeed and did what she could to make that happen. When her apartment flooded and destroyed most of her possessions, her landlord would not fix the problem. Not only did she and her 10-year-old son have nowhere to live, she also was charged with an eviction and had to go to court. Fortunately, the judge found in her favor, but she still had no place to go and sought help at Bethany House. Her case manager, Bernita Bell, said Lawanda was very motivated right from the start. As soon as she entered the shelter and completed her intake paperwork, she rushed out to make it to a job interview on time. In less than a month, Lawanda found an apartment and secured a job at Veteran's Hospital. **Today she and her son are happy, healthy and excited about their futures.**

## "Bethany House gave me freedom"

One year ago on April 3, Cassandra arrived at the shelter with her two daughters – scared, tired and with little will to live. An electrical fire in her home took everything she had. Cassandra bounced from one friend's house to another until she decided it was time to seek help and stabilize her family. "I received a lot of love and even more tough love. All the Staff were so good to me and I heard positive words every day that kept me going. Ms. Gwen told me something that 'brought me back to me' and that was not to ever let anyone steal my joy and her words motivated me to start helping myself."

Two months ago Cassandra began working at Bethany House as a cook and shelter assistant. "I feel great and love coming to work. I have always been a hard worker and I love to cook and clean and keep the shelter organized and looking good. **I can't thank all of you enough for giving me a second chance.**"

## "A new life"

After years of trying to make her marriage work, Amber knew she needed to leave her alcoholic husband and start a new life for herself and her children. She had always loved being a stay-at-home mom but without a college degree and no job experience for over 13 years, she was unable to find a job to support her family. She couldn't afford a lawyer to handle her divorce and unfortunately, she did not get the help she needed financially to survive. When living with friends didn't work out, she ended up at Bethany House. "I am grateful to be here because Bethany House is not just a bed and food – they are helping me get myself together." Amber has utilized Bethany House's partnership with other agencies to get herself back into the workforce. "I am learning interview skills, how to build a resume, how to use Microsoft programs and work etiquette."

There are many women like Amber who have found themselves lost and broken after years of stability. Bethany House not only provides a safe place for these women and their families but also ensures they develop the necessary tools to be stable, secure and ready to tackle whatever comes their way. **"I'm very thankful for Bethany House and the staff are just phenomenal!"**

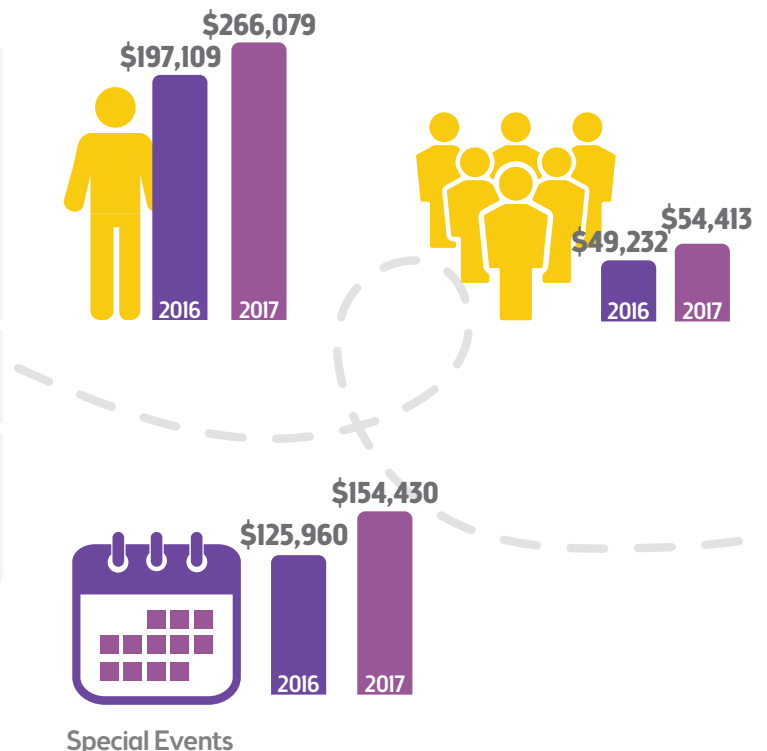
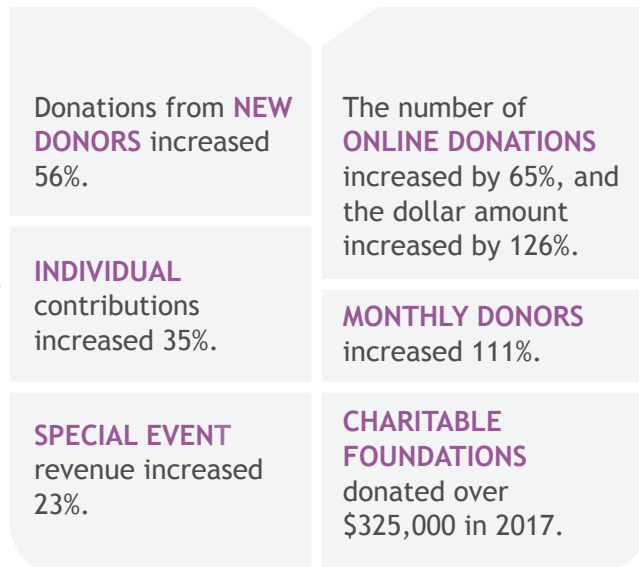

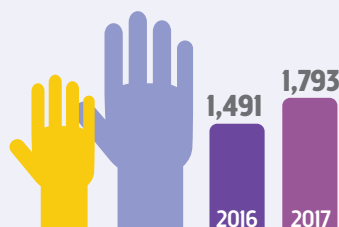
## VOLUNTEERS

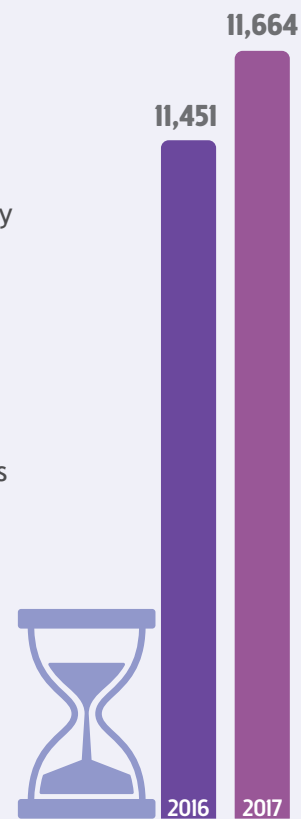

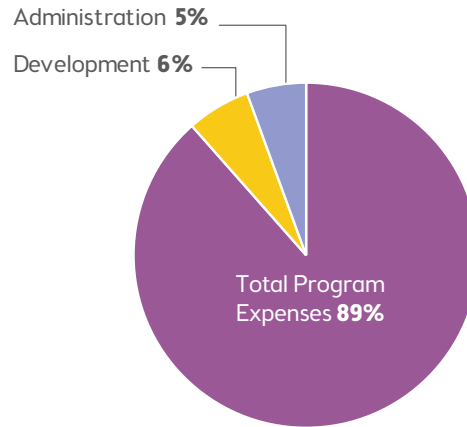

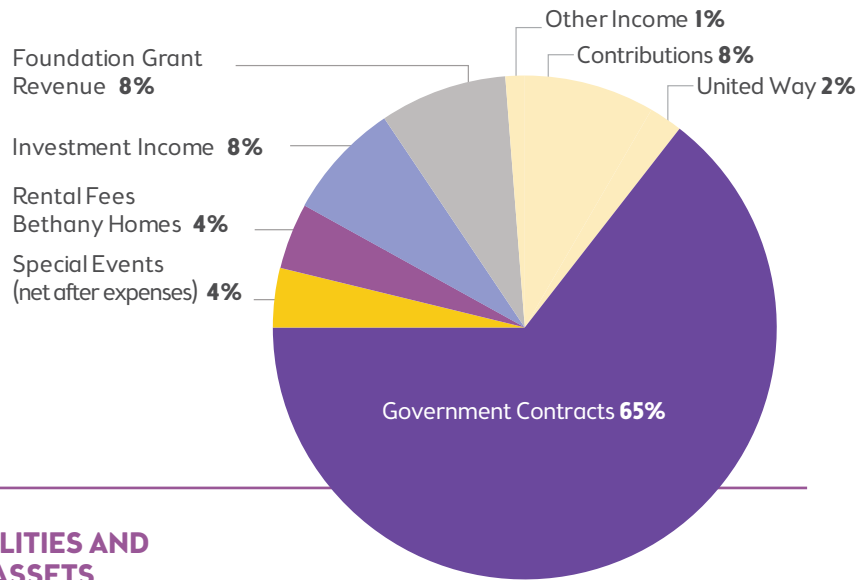

# Bethany's Future



As you have read throughout this Impact Report, 2017 was a year of new partnerships and expanded services, and a year of new funding and a stronger financial position. It was also a year of challenges.

**The biggest barrier to our operations continues to be our facilities.** We deal with six buildings – three apartment buildings in Westwood and College Hill and the three houses on Fairmount that we own (shelter, housing programs and administration). The houses on Fairmount are all close to 130 years old and present all of the infrastructure costs and issues their age implies. It is clear that we need a single facility to house all clients and staff with space for community providers to offer the necessary services our families require.

Mental health issues have become very prevalent over the past few years. As inappropriate or disruptive behavior is noted in a shelter apartment, the family is moved to Fairmount where there is 24/7 supervision, and a mental health clinician is on site five days per week. We are also seeing many more children arrive at the shelter with a plethora of mental health and behavioral issues. While therapists are on site at the Fairmount campus two days a week to help our kids, they need so much more. One building would ensure that every family receives the supervision needed to stay on track and would enable quicker access to mental health services, thereby accelerating their successful completion of the shelter program and movement on to self-sufficiency and independence.



**We believe that 2018 is the year we will see plans finalized for a new building.** For the last three years, a dedicated Board committee has worked countless hours searching for a site, and planning and designing a new facility that will better equip us to provide the top-notch services we've given to Cincinnati's homeless families for the last 34 years.

We are very excited about the future and bringing a one-site Bethany House to reality. With your prayers and with your help, we can accomplish our vision of living in a community where all families have a place to call home!

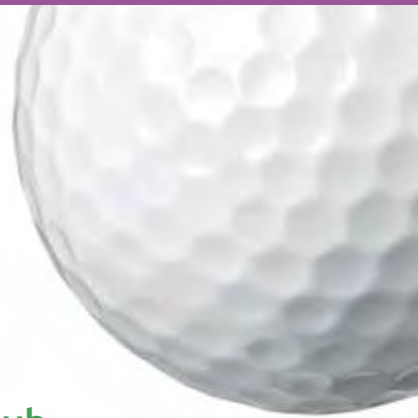
