## Child Care

Child Care is provided while parents attend classes Monday through Thursday from 6:30-8:15pm at our Fairmount shelter located at 1836 Fairmount and Bond Hill location at 1629 Joseph Street, off Reading Road. This is a PERFECT volunteer opportunity for high school students who want to spend time playing with and reading to children. We really need people who can commit to once a week for a three-month period. Childcare volunteers must attend orientation and tour the facility. No background check needed if under 18.

## Host a Dinner

Host a dinner at our Fairmount or Bond Hill Shelter for 45 guests Monday through Thursday evenings. This is the perfect opportunity for a corporate, church, or student groups, a sports team, or a family and friends. Dinner is served at 6:00 pm. Bring food to cook in our full service kitchen or prepare food at home. Volunteers serve and clean up after dinner. The maximum number of volunteers is 8 to 10. Dinner instructions will be provided. Must be chaperoned by at least one adult. *There is also the opportunity to stay after dinner and provide childcare while the parents attend life skills classes. Please check with us first if you would like to help with childcare so it can be noted on the childcare schedule.*

## Host a Breakfast

Host breakfast at our Fairmount or Bond Hill Shelter for 45 guests on Saturday or Sunday mornings. This is the perfect opportunity for a corporate, church, or student groups, a sports team, or a family and friends. Breakfast is served at 9am. Bring food to cook in our full-service kitchen or prepare food at home. Volunteers serve and clean up breakfast. The maximum number of volunteers is 8 to 10. Breakfast instructions will be provided. Must be chaperoned by at least one adult.

## Administrative/Facilities Opportunities

- Yardwork-Help maintain landscaping by weeding, trimming bushes, raking leaves, and trash pick-up and all locations.
- Mailing-Help with mailings at our administration building (1841 Fairmount) during the day.
- Fall and Spring Cleaning-Deep cleaning shelters and offices including bedrooms, playrooms, kitchens, lounges and office spaces.
- Ongoing Tasks-Organizing, moving donations, shredding, and filing.
