
The barriers our single parents face increased dramatically this past year. The shortage of childcare for our youngest children, virtual school for our older children, and a depressed job market all hindered our parents from finding work and increasing their incomes. Equally challenging was finding apartments so families could leave shelter.

During the past year, Bethany House's dedicated and resilient staff maintained or exceeded outcomes for our families equivalent to pre-pandemic levels. We navigated the uncertainties of COVID-19 without any staff reductions or furloughs. We reached our goal of a starting salary of \$15 an hour for staff. We added new positions to help with our children's education and social-emotional development. We successfully managed through a pandemic year and ended with a small surplus. Plus, we raised \$7.5 million toward our capital campaign project!

While COVID-19 continues to challenge our resources, operating capacity, and spirits, our homeless families and staff are successfully moving forward thanks to the unwavering support of our larger Bethany House family.

In this year of upheaval, Bethany House is proud to report that **we provided services to 3,565 individuals from 972 families across all our shelter, housing, and prevention programs.** We were able to do this because of the unbelievable support of our Board of Directors, our Board Committees and all of our donors and volunteers. **Our sincere thanks to each of you! Together we helped our families achieve housing, self-sufficiency and independence!**

## The Impact of COVID on Bethany Families

The pandemic has upended lives around the world. COVID-19 is more than a health crisis. It is a human, economic and social crisis — especially for children and families without a home.

Last March we closed our congregate shelters in Fairmount and Bond Hill, and they are still closed today. Moving families to hotel rooms was just the first step to keep everyone safe and healthy. Finding ways to provide services meant one adjustment after another. Providing three meals a day to 25 families in hotels, ensuring everyone had safety supplies, reassigning staff — every day meant something new.

Families have continued to move from shelter to permanent housing in spite of increased difficulty finding jobs and housing. Case Managers and Housing Specialists connected with parents via phone, FaceTime, and in person, when possible. Virtual school, problems with technology devices and access and the constant changes in district policies put the children in homeless families another year behind (now at least 2 years behind their non-homeless peers) and stressed without behavioral health supports.

A silver lining to the pandemic has been the level of collaboration within our community. All four family shelters, other homeless services providers, the city, county, the United Way, local foundations, and individual donors shared knowledge and resources to keep our children and their families safe. We are grateful to our dedicated partners who problem-solved, innovated, and faced every day determined to help families move from homelessness to shelter, and from shelter to permanent housing.

## Dedication of Bethany House Staff

The dedication and problem-solving ability of Bethany House staff was unsurpassed this past year. They were on the job each and every day of the COVID crisis to ensure families had safe shelter and to support them in their search for employment and housing. When other workers were safe at home, our staff weathered the risk. This commitment to fulfill our mission — to empower families to achieve long term self-sufficiency and housing stability — is the cornerstone of our families' success.

## Susan Schiller Honored as C-Suite Award Winner

In 2020, the Cincinnati Business Courier presented CEO Susan Schiller with the CEO C-Suite Award for her contribution and commitment to the community and her outstanding professional performance.

## THE HIGHLIGHTS

## OUR “SPECIAL SAUCE”

A foundation trustee was reviewing our 2020 outcomes and asked “What’s your ‘Special Sauce?’”

Here is the recipe to Bethany House’s “Special Sauce.”

- 1 Our wrap-around, holistic services**  
We take care of the family’s immediate needs — a safe place to stay, a bed, food, clothing, help finding a job and an apartment, connecting families to medical and mental healthcare, and getting the kids back in school or childcare. We also prevent repeat episodes of homelessness by addressing all of the families’ needs.
- 2 Our unbelievably committed, dedicated, and knowledgeable staff** who are trained in providing trauma-informed care.
- 3 Our focus on the children.** Moms can’t work if the kids’ needs aren’t being met or if they are not in school or day care. 70% of the people in our shelter are kids!
- 4 Our Aftercare and Post-Shelter Support Services** provide help after families leave shelter or after they leave a housing program.

### SHELTER OUTCOMES

In spite of the pandemic, Bethany housed the same number of families in 2020 as 2019

**96%** of families leaving shelter moved to positive housing situations

2-year recidivism rate (return to shelter) was **12%**

**33%** of families left shelter with increased income

Average length of stay in shelter decreased **11%**

In 2020, we sheltered **85% of all homeless families** who were placed in family shelters through the regional homeless helpline (does not include families served by the domestic violence shelter)

## Our programs are effective

In 2020 Bethany House increased their homeless prevention services by **18%**.

**331 families** received case management, financial and/or in-kind support after leaving shelter or a housing program, reducing the risk of repeat homelessness.

Bethany House provided services to **3,565 INDIVIDUALS** from **972 FAMILIES** across all our shelter, housing, and prevention programs.

# TRANSFORMING LIVES

## ADIT

Following a series of ill-fated events, single mom Adit and her two daughters found themselves suddenly homeless on the streets of Cincinnati. Having nowhere to turn, Adit and her girls found themselves at Bethany House. After a difficult journey, she is now proud to share her experiences with Bethany House, hoping that she may inspire others.

“Bethany House took us in, fed us, made sure we had clothes, made sure my daughter was properly enrolled in school, and had everything she needed for school, including a laptop. They gave us bus cards, but more importantly, they encouraged us to become independent and self-sufficient. They encouraged us to eat healthy with nutrition classes, they made sure my daughter received a physical for school, and helped us in numerous ways. The staff at Bethany House helped me in every way they could. They extended every kindness, comfort, and help that they could give to us. I am so thankful to Bethany House; we would not have made it without them.”

## JAMIE

After winning the fight against addiction, Jamie and her family found themselves facing homelessness. Empowered by Bethany House Services she was able to achieve stability in a home of her own.

“I was addicted to drugs for 10-12 years of my life when I ended up pregnant with my daughter. I had to do something to get better. At that point I felt defeated; I was at my worst and just ready to give in. I went through treatment, and when I got out I was behind a few months’ rent, so I had to either come up with the money or find someplace else to go. As I was packing my things, I received a call telling me there was a place for us at Bethany House.

I’m now clean for five years. I have a job where I get to work with others who are in a situation similar to mine. Everyone at Bethany House was really helpful, supportive and caring in my time of struggle. I was discouraged a lot; they were always encouraging me to keep taking one more step forward. Bethany House is an overall miracle for people who are struggling to get back on their feet. The place is amazing, the people are amazing, and I’m just really grateful for my time there.”

# BETHANY HOUSE'S NEW SHELTER



## *In the words of our mothers...*

They welcomed me into their family and took care of me at my darkest time. Finally, I could take a deep breath and figure out what we were going to do. - *Brenda*

I lost my job and we were evicted. It was terrifying and unpredictable at times. To have that security and stability is essential. - *Monique*

## **How has Bethany responded to the increased needs of families experiencing homelessness?**

Bethany House's comprehensive family-centered services provide safety, shelter, food, clothing, life skills classes, case management, children's programs, and physical and mental health care access. Prevention services, including post-shelter stabilization, help families in danger of losing their homes due to a temporary situation secure emergency assistance.

In 2015, we grew from 30 to 130 beds when a local shelter closed, and we accepted management of their three apartment-based family shelters. In 2018, we added 40 "overflow" beds that have been filled ever since. This growth has led to Bethany House operating out of seven locations, none of which were designed to shelter families, and three buildings where we rent apartments. While we continue to provide life-changing services to our families, our facilities have reached capacity. Our buildings are not designed to shelter hundreds of families and as a result, limit the level of service and programming we can provide. The physical structures significantly challenge efficient and effective operation and hinder our ability to provide the best possible services to our families.



# AND SERVICES CENTER

## Why do we need a new shelter?

The number of families in need of emergency shelter and the severity of the barriers to safe housing continue to rise in Greater Cincinnati. Calls to the regional homeless helpline increased 22% in 2019 and another 24% in 2020. It is no longer enough to provide food and a safe, clean place to sleep—moms, dads, and kids need on-site mental and physical healthcare, education, parenting counseling, employment services and connections to community services.

While demand for family shelter continues to grow, our facilities are holding us back. Families are now scattered among five shelters and must travel among the buildings for services; this is costly and time-consuming, and the scattered sites means unequal access to programs.

## What is the solution?

To address our community's need, Bethany House is building a new family homeless shelter and comprehensive services center. This consolidation of seven buildings into a single facility will enable Bethany House to provide the best quality of care and improve access to a full-range of supportive services to every family it serves—and it will enable Bethany House to serve more than 100 additional families in shelter each year. Additionally, the average length of stay for families in shelter is expected to decrease by 30% because of the improved efficiency and effectiveness of providing all services under one roof. Fewer families will be sleeping in abandoned buildings, in their cars, or on the streets of Cincinnati.

## Why Bethany House?

As the region's largest family shelter, Bethany House is uniquely positioned to increase services to reach more families and ensure vulnerable families receive the best possible care and experiences. This new building will increase the services we are able to provide to families who are most in need, ultimately breaking the intergenerational cycle of homelessness.

Importantly, the new facility is designed specifically for homeless parents and children. It will incorporate trauma-informed care into its design, including private family bedrooms, communal-style common spaces and age-appropriate enrichment areas as well as indoor and outdoor children's play spaces. These elements have been shown to be effective for serving homeless families and minimizing trauma.

## How can we achieve our vision of a new shelter?

Our campaign strategy seeks to bring together public, private and tax credit support to reach our goal. Bethany House has already seen tremendous community support and more than \$12.4 million has been raised to date, 82% from private funding sources. New Markets Tax Credits could provide more than \$2.5 million for the project.

## Can you help?

Bethany House is urgently working to reach our fundraising goal in the second quarter of this year so that we can secure tax credits and begin construction. Can you help your neighbors in their time of need?

# DIVERSITY, EQUITY AND INCLUSION



Following the racial unrest in 2020, the attention of a nation focused on the inequalities and inequities many Americans face each day. Bethany House has always valued diversity, equity and inclusion at all levels of the organization. Here is an update on our efforts to create opportunities for all people this past year.

## Economic Inclusion

The families we serve are always the poorest in our community and the first to be negatively impacted by economic downturns and health threats. Ninety percent of shelter guests are people of color, including 1%-2% reporting Hispanic ethnicity. Virtually all families have incomes below 200% of the federal poverty guidelines. Ninety-three percent of families are headed by a single mother. Bethany House's holistic services include job readiness, employment counseling and services. In 2020, despite the pandemic, 33% of families left shelter with increased income and 43% of families increased or maintained income when leaving our Rapid Re-Housing program.

## Board Diversity

Since 2014 Bethany House's Strategic Plans have specifically identified goals to diversify board membership on race, gender, age,

and lived homeless experience. The number of people of color has grown from 5% to 28% during that time. Bethany House's new 2021-2023 Strategic Plan continues the focus on diversity and inclusion.

## Supporting Front-Line Staff

Cincinnati's childhood poverty rates are due in part to the low income of their parents. Bethany House made a commitment to ensure all staff received a living wage and increased the starting salaries of our front-line staff to \$15 per hour.

## DEI in the Construction of New Building

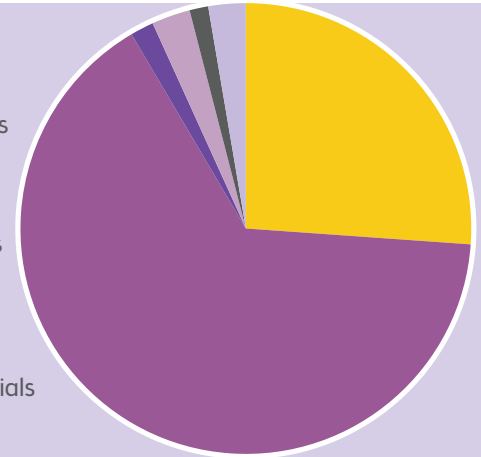
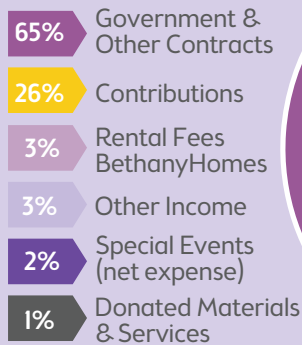
